# **Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)**

### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Approximately 378,300 PCR tests were conducted.
- 314 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 15,731.
- At present there are 5,096 active cases, 12 of them in critical condition.
- 280 additional cases recovered bringing total individuals recovered to 10,606.
- 2 new mortalities, a 84-year-old female Bahraini national and 78-year-old resident, both suffered from underlying and chronic health problems.
- In response to questions, the MoH clarifies the services permitted to be provided in women's salons, provided that health precautions are followed.
- 1150 violations were recorded for not wearing the "face mask" in public places.
- King Fahd Causeway Authority (KFCA) denies opening the bridge.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.




