## **Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)**

### Situation Report No. 72 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 10 June 2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Approximately 386,130 PCR tests were conducted.
- 469 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 16,200; 58.3% of new cases are expatriates.
- At present there are 5,148 active cases, 14 of them in critical condition.
- 378 additional cases recovered bringing total individuals recovered to 11,487.
- 2 new mortalities, a 72-year-old female Bahraini national and a 71-year-old resident, both suffered from underlying and chronic health problems.
- Coronavirus is now more prevalent among Bahrainis than expatriates.
- Ministry of Health warns of the risk of not following the precautionary measures.
- 296 Egyptians left Manama to Cairo.
- Embassy of Bahrain in London holds a video lecture (Bahrain's efforts to combat Coronavirus pandemic) attended by a number of Members of Parliament and foreign diplomats in the UK.
- A Bahraini attends a family gathering in Ramadan and transmits the infection to 16 people.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission: transmission is known to occur by symptomatic cases (infected people with symptoms) and presymptomatic cases (who later develop symptoms). More data is still needed about transmission via asymptomatic cases (who never develop symptoms). See link below.
