



HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were: 1 citizen (a 75 year-old female) and 3 expatriates (35, 39 year-old males and a 65 year-old female).
- Dubai's Emirates airlines resumes flights to and from Bahrain.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission: transmission is known to occur by symptomatic cases (infected people with symptoms) and presymptomatic cases (who later develop symptoms). More data is still needed about transmission via asymptomatic cases (who never develop symptoms). See link below.
