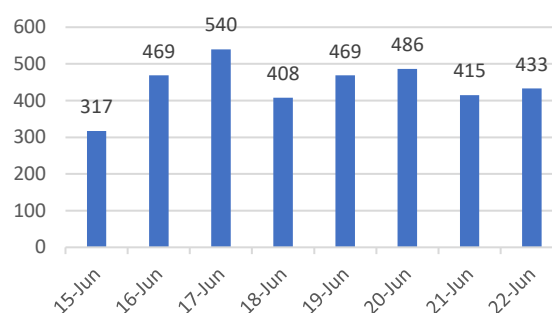

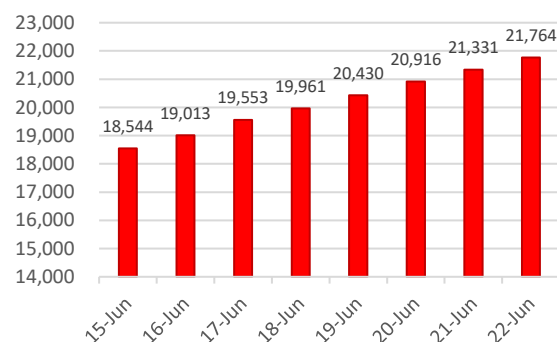
HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were 2 male Bahraini citizens (87 and 90 years-old).
- Bahrain International Airport implements additional safety measures including: mandatory face masks, access allowed only to travellers and employees, arrival to the airport min. 3 hours before travel, etc.
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission, See link below.

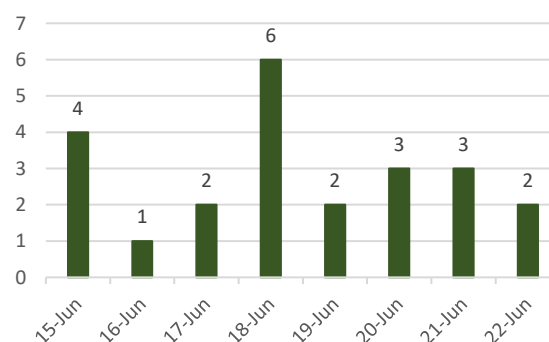
Number of New Cases
