

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were: 1 male Bahraini citizens (44 yearsold) and 4 male expatriates (37, 44, 48 and 58 years-old).
- 6,128 violations recorded for not wearing face masks in public places since it was mandated.
- Licensing of the first 2 factories for the production of pharmaceuticals in the Kingdom, production is expected to commence on September 2020.
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
