





HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 52-year-old male Bahraini citizen.
- 9,226 violations of not wearing a face mask in public places since it was mandated on the 9th of April.
- MoH launched health requirements to be applied in beaches: 5 persons is the maximum number of groups on "private" beaches and two meters as a social distance.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission, See link below.
