





#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Out of total confirmed cases: 84.3% recovery rate and 0.32% mortality rate.
- Members of Parliament have urged the government to review Commercial Registration requirements for businesses adversely impacted by the coronavirus disease.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroguine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
