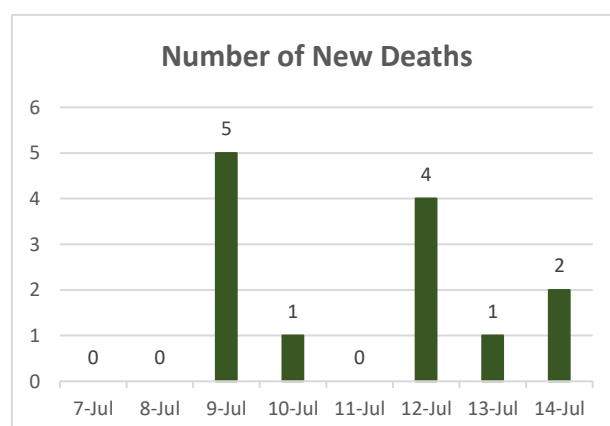
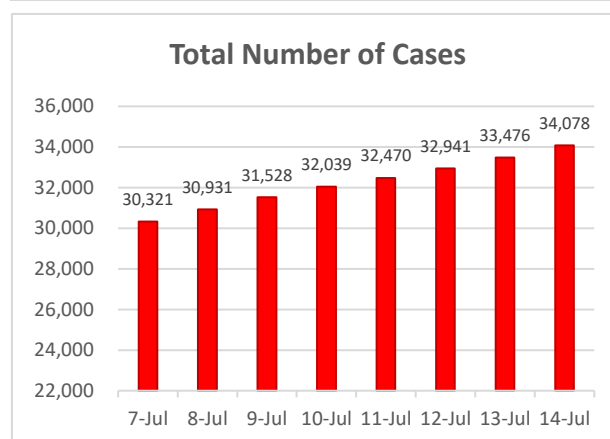
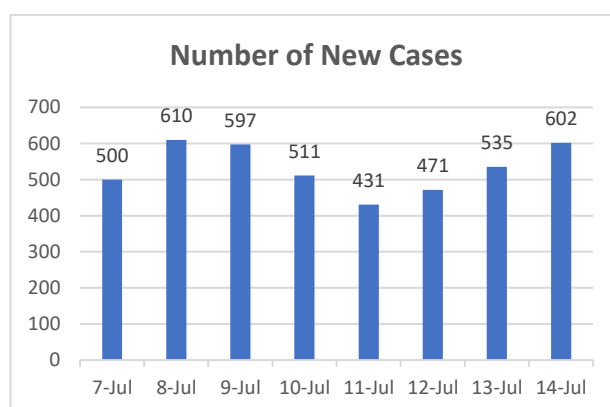

HIGHLIGHTS

- Death of 1 male Bahraini citizen 86 years old and 1 male expatriate 59 years old.
- The application of telemedicine services allows individuals to get medical consultations, the results of laboratory tests and renew prescriptions for medicines.
- Northern Governorate distributed over 6,500 food parcels to support Bahraini families affected by the crisis of Covid-19.
- Southern Governor attends disinfection campaign which was launched to disinfect public facilities.
- UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million.
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
