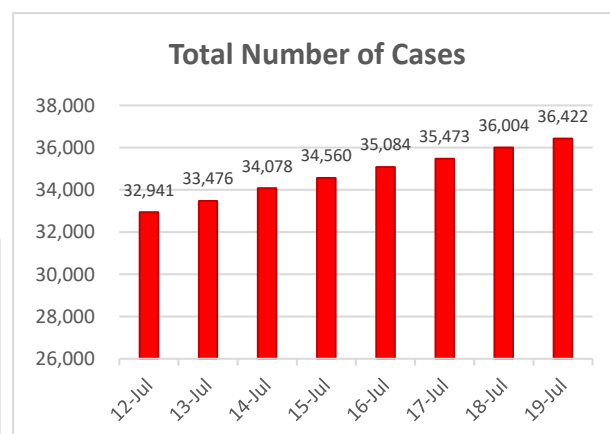
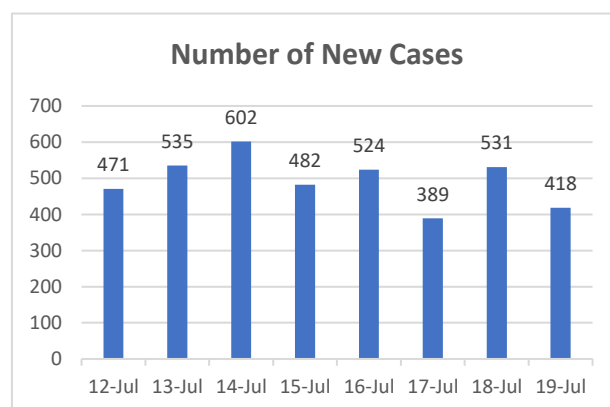

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were 1 Bahraini male citizen (78 years old) and 1 male expatriate (59 years old).
- The southern governorate receives 2,000 medical masks from the Bahraini Association for the Development of Women.
- 2 Bahraini doctors working in the UK are on the frontlines of the fight against Covid-19.
- UN report forecasts increase in hunger and malnutrition globally as a result of COVID-19; in 2019 it was estimated that 690 million people went hungry, by the end of 2020 the number may increase by an additional 130 million, see link below.
