Each Bidder must submit the Technical Proposal and the Cost Proposal in separate binders (and as separate electronic documents). Prices or rates (in USD/JOD) submitted as part of the Cost Proposal shall not appear in any other part of the proposal to ensure that the Technical and Cost Proposals can be evaluated independently. Proposals received in any other manner will be invalidated.
