
Distribution of COVID-19 laboratory supplies to 34 provinces in Afghanistan.

#### **EPIDEMIOLOGICAL HIGHLIGHTS**


- **COVID-19 cases and deaths:** As of 26 March 2022, the Eastern Mediterranean Region has reported 21 551 271 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 340 310 deaths since the start of the pandemic.
- **Epidemiological trend:** during the reporting period, in comparison with the previous two weeks:
  - The number of reported cases decreased by 66%
  - The number of reported deaths decreased by 60%
  - The number of conducted tests decreased by 22%
  - No countries reported increases in deaths or cases
  - 21 countries reported a simultaneous decrease in cases and deaths
- **COVID-19 testing:** The total number of tests in the Region has reached 362 965 967 with a median cumulative positivity ratio of 10.3% (range from 0.6% to 34.8%).
- Variants of concern (VOCs):
  - 21 countries/territories in the Region have officially reported the detection of the Alpha VOC.
  - 18 countries/territories in the Region have officially reported the detection of the Beta VOC.
  - 6 countries/territories in the Region have officially reported the detection of the Gamma VOC.
  - 20 countries/territories in the Region have officially reported the detection of the Delta VOC.
  - 17 countries/territories in the Region have officially reported the detection of the Omicron VOC.

### **Map 2:** Countries reporting SARS-CoV-2 Variants of Concern (VOCs) in the Eastern Mediterranean Region








## **Graph 1:** Weekly distribution of COVID-19 cases in the Eastern Mediterranean Region

#### **REGIONAL RESPONSE HIGHLIGHTS**

#### **Health Operations and Technical Expertise**

#### Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)

- Conducted a week-long mission to Yemen to follow up on the implementation of national and facility IPC programmes, supporting the implementation of priority IPC practices within hospitals, and training 75 health care workers from ten primary and tertiary healthcare facilities on IPC in the context of COVID-19.
- Conducted a week-long mission to Iraq to support the Ministry of Health in enhancing the national IPC programme, visiting four hospitals in Baghdad to support IPC implementation, and training 30 IPC staff from 10 hospitals, mainly on IPC multimodal interventions.
- Reviewed and updated the Syrian national IPC guidelines and documents in the context of COVID-19.

#### Research and Knowledge Management

• Organized a webinar on "Bioethics Education in the Challenging Times of COVID-19" on 14 March with WHO Collaborating Centers for Bioethics, hosted by EMR institutions in the Islamic Republic of Iran, Lebanon, and Pakistan, and with UNESCO/Arab States sharing their experience.

#### **Essential Health Services and Systems**

- Initiated a plan for the Priority Benefits Package (PBP) in countries in fragile and conflict-affected situations.
- Prepared a summary of the key considerations for developing a PBP in the EMR.

#### COVID-19 Vaccine

- Kicked off the COVID-19 Vaccination Delivery Partnership for Somalia and Syria where all partners provide support in a concerted manner.
- Completed country missions to Afghanistan and Yemen to accelerate COVID-19 vaccination.
- Supported the Advance Market Commitment (AMC) GAVI-eligible countries in applying for COVID-19 vaccine delivery support.
- Prepared cards with educational messages for Ramadan and updated the Ramadan guidance.
