- Increased understanding among all groups on the assessment and appraisal of evidence.
- Encourage more countries in the Region to follow

- Need for a national guideline program for adaptation and contextualization of international guidelines, even without national evidence
- Prioritization of guideline topics and the key minimum criteria
- Adoption vs Adaptation vs De novo Synthèses
- Who should be in a guideline development group?
- Scoping of guidelines and formulating PICO questions
 - Groups presented PICOs questions of given topics
