## Week No. 23: (4 Jun- 10 Jun 2017)





#### Highlights:

- ❖ (4) AFP cases were reported during this week, (3) cases from Al-Mayadin in Deir-ez-Zor, (1) case from Rural Damascus.
- ❖ A notable decrease in SM cases reported for three consecutive weeks.
- ❖ (58) Suspected Measles cases were reported during this week: from Ar-Raqqa (17), Damascus (17), Deirez-Zor (14), and Dar'a (6).

### Completeness& Timeliness of Reporting


The overall completeness of reporting was 81%, (910 out of total 1132 EWARS sentinel sites), (14) Governorates have reported this week; Timeliness of reporting was 80%.



#### The Morbidity Cases


- Out of the 205,395 total consultations, a total of 17,213 EWARS notifiable cases were reported; of which 7,219cases were Influenza like Illness (36%), 7,032 cases were Acute Diarrhoea (35%), 348 cases of AJS, 130 cases of Sever Acute Respiratory Infection, 58 cases of Suspected Measles, 78 cases of Bloody Diarrhoea, 36 cases of Suspected Meningitis, and 4 cases of Acute Flaccid Paralysis.
- Graphs 1 and 2 below show the proportional morbidity among < 5 and  $\ge 5$  year age groups respectively.


- ❖ AD constitutes (46.49%) among < 5 and (36%) among ≥ 5, while ILI constitutes (39.90%) of the cases among <5 and (44%) among ≥ 5.
- ❖ 51% of the cases were distributed among males, 56% of the cases were distributed among≥5 age group. In total 2,308 cases were reported as "other diseases". The most important diseases reported within this group were; 371 cases of Leishmaniasis (most of which were reported from Idleb 48%, Hama 27%), 231 cases of Typhoid (most of which were reported from Deir-Ez-Zor 25%, Idleb 30%, and Rural Damascus 13%), 175 cases of Brucellosis, 34 cases of Mumps, 32 cases of Pertussis, and 10 cases of TB.

**Graph 3** shows the trend analysis of suspected Measles cases reported between week 1 and week 22 of 2016 and 2017. It shows a decrease in reported SM cases for three consecutive weeks.




**Graph 4**: shows the distribution of Suspected Measles cases per governorates reported during week 23 of 2017.
