Join the WHO Fellows@EMRO programme

The World Health Organization (WHO) is committed to investing in the development of its staff to ensure a competent and dynamic workforce is in place to deliver on the Organization's core commitments to Member States and fulfil its mission of achieving "Health for all by All".

WHO's regional Vision 2023 prioritizes building the capacities of future public health professionals and to support this objective, a new fellowship programme "Fellows@EMRO" is being launched in the WHO Regional Office.

The programme will provide an opportunity for young health professionals from low- and middle-income countries of the Region to be exposed to the work of WHO and increase their understanding of national, regional and global public health issues through placements in the WHO Regional Office for the Eastern Mediterranean in Cairo, Egypt, or at a WHO country office.

The programme will assign successful applicants from diverse academic backgrounds to WHO technical programmes in which their educational experience will be enhanced through practical assignments and on-the-job training.

Who can apply?

Young professionals from low- and middle-income countries of WHO's Eastern Mediterranean Region (Afghanistan, Djibouti, Egypt, Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Pakistan, Palestine, Somalia, Sudan, Syrian Arab Republic, Tunisia and Yemen) can apply.

Programme duration?


Once selected a fellow will participate in the programme for between 3 and 6 months.
