



Figure 2 - COVID-19 Patients in Intensive Care, 26 March 2020 - 14 January 2022






Figure 3 - Number of Daily COVID-19 PCR Tests and Percentage of Positive Cases, 13 April 2020 - 14 January 2022


Guillain-Barré syndrome and COVID-19 vaccines




Guillain-Barré syndrome is a **rare disorder** that occurs when the immune system accidentally attacks the nerves coming out of the spinal cord. **Most people affected recover fully**.

There have been **very rare** reports of cases of Guillain-Barré syndrome after vaccination with the AstraZeneca and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccines.

It is not yet known whether these cases are connected to or caused by the vaccines.

If the number of admitted COVID-19 patients in a city is <2 per 100,000 populations per day, the status of that city will be blue; if the number is \geq 2 and <4 per 100,000 populations, the status will be yellow; if the number is \geq 4 and <6, the status will be orange; an if the number increases to \geq 6, the status will be red.

The status of the cities is being updated in the Mask app, endorsed by Iran's Ministry of Health and Medical Education, Link to the Mask application website: https://mask.ir/

Business Category

Imposed National and Provincial Restrictions

As a patient-tracking measure, all citizens are required to be in possession of their national ID cards as a prerequisite to gain entry to government offices, receive public services, or use public transport.

As of 21 November 2020, the following scheme, called "smart management of restrictions," has been implemented nationwide. In this scheme, the alert level for the cities is reviewed weekly, and corresponding closures/openings are applied for one week. More details on the alert level of cities

can be found on the risk map and provincial capitals risk status table.

Technical Deputy of Ministry of Health Environmental and Occupational Health Center announced that reception halls are allowed to operate in cities of blue and yellow status. The maximum number of participants allowable in a hall is 75 people in blue cities and 55 in yellow ones. However, in outdoor halls the maximum capacity may be twice these numbers. The maximum duration of events is 3 hours.

For a period of 15 days starting from December 19th, 2021, all Iranian passengers travelling from the United Kingdom, Norway, Denmark, and France may be subject to an additional PCR test at the border.

General restrictions:

Except the excluded passengers, all arriving passengers must have negative PCR test result issued at most 72 hours prior to their travel to Iran regardless of duration of stay overseas along with the official proof of vaccination. The test result must be in English or stamped and confirmed by Iranian consulates. Passengers without negative test result are not allowed to enter Iran. If the international traveler is arriving from the high-risk countries (list is annexed), at least 14 days must have been passed from the second dose of vaccination. In addition, if airport authorities diagnose passengers with COVID-19 symptoms, another PCR test will be taken at the airport.

Passengers arriving from or who have transited through Botswana, Eswatini, Lesotho, Malavi, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa and Zimbabwe in the past 14 days are not allowed to enter and nationals and residents of IRAN are subjected to a COVID-19 test upon arrival and quarantine for 14 days at a hotel in airport.

Passengers with a medical certificate issued longer than 72 hours before travel are subject to medical screening. Coronavirus (COVID-19) PCR test and quarantine upon arrival, at their own expense.

E-visas can be obtained before departure at http://e_visa.mfa. ir/en/.

Passengers must have an e-visa confirmation.

All arriving passengers would be subject to medical screening and clinical assessment and in case of showing symptoms would be tested again. The passenger will be guarantined in assigned locations until receiving the test result and in case of positive test result, the passenger will be accommodated in assigned quarantine locations for 14 days. Passenger shall incur costs for the test and accommodation. (IKIA Information Center)

All arriving passengers are required to fill out "COVID-19 Self Declaration Form" before arrival provided by the airline operators prior or during the flights and hand over the completed forms to the Airlines' agents. The form can be obtained at https://tinyurl.com/2amxzs3u /
