


IRAQ: Mobile Medical Clinics response in Dahuk Governorate

(Reporting period from week 15 to week 18, April 2015)

MOBILE MEDICAL CLINICS OVERVIEW

Department of Health (DoH) was provided with four Mobile Medical Clinics (MMC) on 23rd January, 2015 with the financial support of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. All the MMCs are operational and working in four different districts (Zakho, Sumel, Shekhan, Bardarash) were high concentration of IDPs are present in Duhok Governorate.

During April; the number of consultation recorded by these four MMC was 16,966 consultations. Out the consultations recorded during this period, 7,813 cases (46%) were Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI), 1,324 cases (7,8%) were skin diseases followed by 753 cases (4,4%) of hypertention. 538 cases (3,2%) has eye infections while 690 cases (4%) complaint of diabetes.

79% of the consultations made by these MMCs were above 5 years of age and 21% were under five years. Average from the consultations during this period showed that of 54% of the consultations were females and 46% were male who required medical attention through these four MMCs.

The highest number of consultations 9,750 was carried out by MMC working in the Sumel district, followed by 4,206 consultations provided by the MMC working in Esyen District. The MMC working Bardarash district provided 1,915 consultations and the lowest number of consultations of 1,095 per provided by the MMC working in Zakho district.


Neither major alerts nor outbreaks were generated or deducted by the MMC working is the four districts of Zakho, Sumel, Shekhan, Bardarash.

The distribution of female consultations in Chamisku camp is 82% as the MMC is providing mother and child health care services.




