Week 7: 15 February – 21 February 2014

HIGHLIGHTS

- The completeness of reporting is 100%; 526out of 526 health facilities provided weekly surveillance data in the epidemiological week 7
- The third round for Polio will start on Saturday 2/3/2014 till Thursday 6/3/2014
- A cluster of Measles was confirmed in Al -Jafer area (Ma'an governorate)
- Diarrhea cases in both Der Alla and Jarash exceeded the upper threshold.
- A case of Tetanus was reported from Mafraq, borne at hospital on 16/12, admitted on 15/2, was circumcised at home on 11/2; patient still did not receive any dose of vaccine except BCG

PRIORITY DISEASES


*The red line represents disease threshold which is the 90 percentile of 25 weeks period (current week, 2 weeks before and 2 weeks afterfrom last 5 years)

1.Cholera

No cases of cholera were reported in Jordan since year 1981;69stool specimens werecultured for Cholera in this week, all were negative.


2. Bloody Diarrhea

 13 cases were reported from UNRWA (these cases are form different clinics belong to UNRWA)



3. Measles

- Passive and active surveillance for Measles revealed the confirmation of 9 cases of Measles
- Five cases who had rash and fever and conjunctivitis and were reported by passive surveillance last week, detect other six cases by active surveillance from different age groups
- Blood samples results confirmed 9 out of 11 (IgM)
- Cumulative cases 2014: 9 lab. confirmed and 2 epidemiologically confirmed




4. Meningococcal Meningitis

No Meningococcal meningitis cases were reported in this week.


5. Acute Flaccid Paralysis

- No cases of AFP were reported in this week
- Cumulative cases in 2014: Five cases
- Last confirmed polio case in Jordan was in 1992




6. Cutaneous Leishmaniasis

- 3 cases of C. Leishmaniasis were reported in this week (one case from Der Alla and 2 Karak)
- Cumulative cases 2014: 18 cases
- Cumulative number of cases for 2013 was 30 cases; these cases mostly were from South Shouneh, Karak and North Agwar.




7. Hepatitis A

12 cases were reported from different sites
 Cases were distributed from 7 reporting sites including four cases from UNRWA but not clustered from a certain area.



8. Severe Acute Respiratory Illness (SARI) sentinel sites

- No positive specimens for Influenza was detected out of 24 tested specimens
- Although of the reported Sporadic cases of Pandemic Influenza (H1N1) 2009 from different hospitals in the country SARI sentinel surveillance detect only H3N2,
- Current circulate serotype of influenza from sentinel sites is H3N2.

Diarrhea

Diarrhea:

- 1421 cases of diarrhea from all reporting
- Jarash and Der Alla exceeded the upper threshold, while in Ajloun number of cases was on the upper threshold
- In Jarash and Der Alla, investigations are ongoing
- 54% of cases were less than 5 years
- Males represents 53% of cases
