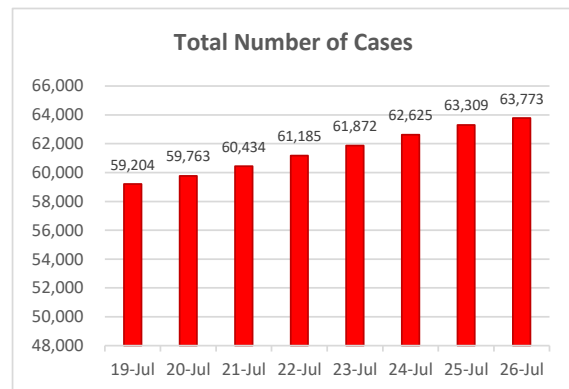
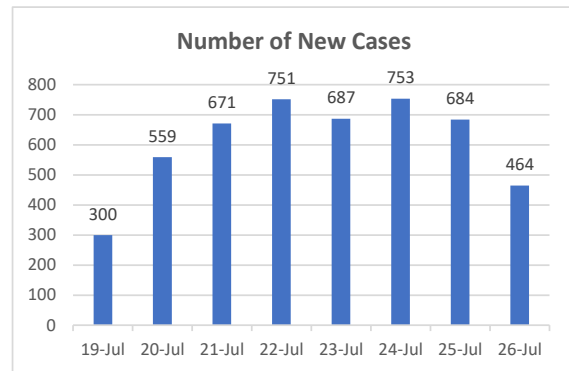

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Kuwait Institute for Scientific Research said in a statement that its researchers proved that COVID-19 can transmit via air.
- Farwaniya residents return to work today as lockdown ends.
- Kuwait Airways announced the resumption of flights to 7 destinations from August 1st which includes Dubai, Manama, Beirut, Cairo, London, Geneva and Turkey (Istanbul, Bodrum and Trabzon).
- All travellers to and from Kuwait have to register on kuwaitmosafer.com before their flight.
- The Red Crescent distributes clothes for 5,000 families in Kuwait.
