## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Municipality closes 14 shops in July due to violating COVID-19 safety measures after more than 128 violations and 280 warnings to several shops, markets and groceries.
- Government developing guidelines to organize 2020 National Assembly elections amid COVID-19.
- A proposal is put forward allowing passengers to arrive to Kuwait from the countries on the 31 ban list on condition they bear the expenses of institutional quarantine.
- Since the resumption of commercial flights on August first, 10,975 passengers left the country and 6,848 passengers arrived.
