- Teachers and administrators start attending schools in a staggered manner, school year starts 4th of October.
- Large numbers of Kuwaitis and residents spend the night outdoors after the end of the curfew.
- Shopping in Kuwait cooperatives reverts to normal after stoppage of the appointments system, where shoppers had to take appointments in order to be able to shop for the past 138 days.
- The list of 32 travel-ban countries remains unchanged.
