## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- The Government decided to postpone the transition to the fifth phase of the return to normalcy plan until further notice.
- Intensive care and bed capacity for Covid-19 patients increased by 5% during last week.
- Increase in number of infected members of parliament to 5 led to the postponement of the regular parliament session to next week.
- 3 more countries added to the list from where travellers are not allowed to enter Kuwait, the countries are France, Argentina and Yemen.
