• Kuwait in the process to approve the import of an American vaccine against COVID-19 after US's announcement that a vaccine will be available within 3 to 4 weeks.

- The Ministry of Health is considering a proposal to reduce the mandatory quarantine period to 3 7 days.
- More than 2,000 violations in all six governorates and KD 100 fine for failing to wear masks in public.
- MoH opens a drive-through PCR test facility in Sabhan area with a capacity of 1,000 reviewers per day.
- Kuwait Municipality sets precautionary measures for mourners in cemeteries in accordance with COVID-19 guidelines.
- 1st Caesarean operation conducted on a COVID-19 infected woman.
- Yemen , France and Argentine have been added to the list of banned countries from entering Kuwait while Singapore has been removed.
