
The National Assembly adjourns session on Wednesday due to lack of quorum in the absence of MPs infected with Coronavirus.
COVID-19 stopped Kuwaiti citizens from receiving medical treatment abroad (estimated at hundreds of millions of KD annually) for more than 6 months, bringing to the front the discussion of the value of such treatment.

Dozens of employees at the Kuwait University were found to be positive for COVID-19 after conducting a random swab test.
