HIGHLIGHTS

• The Sri Lankan Embassy in Kuwait has been closed until 11th October after

3 staff members and 44 migrant workers contracted the coronavirus.

• Ministry of Education was closed on Thursday for sterilization after

increase in coronavirus infections.

• 116 Indian nurses returned to Kuwait despite arriving from a country on the 34 country ban list; and that led stranded Filipino staff of MoH to appeal for entering Kuwait as well.

• Government approves using charter flights to bring in stranded staff from banned countries directly to Kuwait, followed by institutional quarantine.

• The Austrian Ministry of Foreign Affairs has issued travel waring to 19 countries which include Kuwait.

• "Their Life is Precious" initiative is launched to support mental health teams for people with disabilities to address the effects of COVID-19.
