• Discovery of coronavirus infections forces work suspension at the Audit Department of the Ministry of Social Affairs.


• Health authorities warn that return of partial curfew is possible after increase in COVID-19 ICU admissions and deaths in the past 2 days and failure to adhere to health precaution.


