HIGHLIGHTS

- Ministry of Foreign of Affairs has allowed 429 Saudi teachers to enter Kuwait according to the schools' need.
- 62 Indian nurses and technicians working for the Ministry of Health were flown back on a special flight and will undergo a shortened quarantine of 7 days.
- Ministry of Health: The winter vaccination campaign for the 2020-2021 season is limited to citizens at the current time.
- Ethiopia becomes a new transit location for expatriates returning to Kuwait.
- 1,000 Filipino workers have been repatriated via free tickets for facing financial, visa or legal situations.
- 60% of hotels are dormant or have been forced to shut down under the current circumstances.
- The Embassy of the Republic of Korea will be temporarily closed from 18 to 20 October for sterilization as one of the Embassy staff tested positive for COVID-19.
