## HIGHLIGHTS

- Ministry of Health publishes the categories to be vaccinated with seasonal influenza.
- Camping season ban imposed by the government causes losses for tent makers; a governmental proposal to have an appointment system for dining in cafes and restaurants is apposed by owners.

Elections for the national assembly are planned to take place on the 5th of December.

- Government asks citizens and expatriates to realize the seriousness of the situation as winter approaches and continue committing to the public health precautions and preventive measures.


