HIGHLIGHTS

- Influenza vaccination is at the first phase, the second phase will target medical staff, and individuals with risk factors, expatriates will start receiving the vaccine in the third phase.
- 28 MoH Filipino staff arrived in Kuwait last Monday onboard a charter flight, 30 more MoH staff and 9 of their dependents are still stranded and waiting for travel clearance to travel to Kuwait directly.
- The last of 19 charter flights departed to the Philippines last Sunday with 228 on board; none of the passengers on this flight were deportees.
