

HIGHLIGHTS

- The Government agreed to the return of domestic workers and asked the Corona Emergency Committee to prepare a plan for their safe return.
- MoH has ordered around 1,000,000 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine produced by Pfizer. The first batch of 150,000 doses is expected to be received by the end of 2020. Meanwhile, MoH decided not to purchase vaccines from other producers until safety and efficacy are demonstrated.
- Students at College of Engineering and Petroleum in Kuwait University refuse to take the exams of the first semester in person fearing COVID-19.



IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS

Definition of a Contact: A contact is a person who has experienced any one of the following exposures during the 2 days before and the 14 days after the onset of symptoms of a probable or confirmed case: **1.** face-to-face contact with a probable or confirmed case within 1 metre and for at least 15 minutes; **2.** direct physical contact with a probable or confirmed case; **3.** direct care for a patient with probable or confirmed COVID-19 disease without using recommended personal protective equipment; OR **4.** other situations as indicated by local risk assessments.
