

HIGHLIGHTS

- MoH announces the there is no obligation on health care workers to take the COVID-19 vaccine when it becomes available.
- Lifting the travel ban from the 34 countries is postponed until after the National Assembly elections. The cabinet also discussed the return plans, expecting 80,000 domestic workers to return to Kuwait over 5 months after lifting the ban.
- Ministry of Health to purchase 3,000,000 doses of the Oxford University vaccine when officially approved.
- \bullet UN International Organization for Migration (IOM) mission distributed protection kits to more than 4,000 expatriate workers.



IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS

Probable COVID-19 case:

• A patient who meets clinical criteria (see *Important Definitions* in situation reports of last week) AND is a contact of a probable or confirmed case, or epidemiologically linked to a cluster with at least one confirmed case. • A suspect case with chest imaging showing findings suggestive of COVID-19 disease. • A person with recent onset of anosmia (loss of smell) or ageusia (loss of taste) in the absence of any other identified cause. • Death, not otherwise explained, in an adult with respiratory distress preceding death AND was a contact of a probable or confirmed case or epidemiologically linked to a cluster with at least one confirmed case.

Confirmed COVID-19 case:

A person with laboratory confirmation of COVID-19 infection, irrespective of clinical signs and symptoms.
