

# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 23 - Kuwait



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 7 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 743 confirmed cases, 78 new cases.
- No new mortalities recorded.
- 637 cases remain under treatment, 23 of them are in critical condition.
- 105 cases recovered and were discharged.
- 2,474 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Kuwait announced two new coronavirus recoveries, a two-year-old boy and a 72-year-old man, bringing the total to 105.
- Minister of Public Works announces assignment of isolation facilities for incoming migrant workers.
- 7 shops were closed by authorities due to violation of COVID-19 mitigation measures.

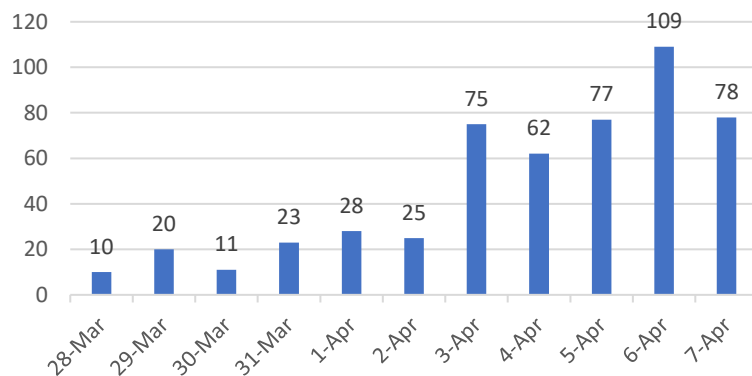
