

# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)



## Situation Report No. 29 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 13 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 1,300 confirmed cases, 66 new cases.
- 1 new mortality recorded.
- 1,148 cases remain under treatment, 26 of them are in critical condition.
- Recovery of 8 coronavirus cases, bringing total to 150.
- 1,367 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Out of the 66 new cases, 5 are Kuwaiti citizens and 61 are expatriates.
- Ministry of Health is accepting volunteers from the private medical sector in its COVID-19 combating efforts
- A large scale repatriation plan for Kuwaiti nationals begins April 19, and lasts till 7 May. There are 50,000 Kuwaiti nationals abroad.

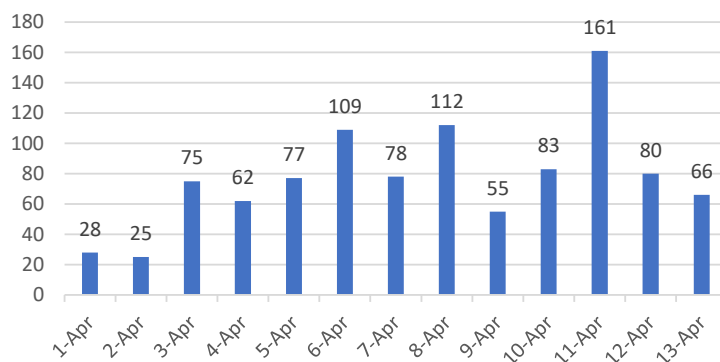
