Situation Report No. 31 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 15 April 2020



HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 1,405 confirmed cases, 50 new cases.
- No new mortalities recorded.
- 1,196 cases remain under treatment, 31 of them are in critical condition.
- recovery of 30 coronavirus cases bringing total to 206.
- 1,367 individuals remain guarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Out of the 50 new cases, 3 are Kuwaiti citizens and 47 are expatriates.
- Interior Ministry sets venues to host Indian nationals who breached residency law and desire to go home.
- Flights carrying expatriates to their home countries continue.
- 4 new emergency wards for COVID-19 cases, 20-beds each, were set up in 4 hospitals.
- WHO updates its COVID-19 strategy on the 14th of April, see link below.
- On 7-8 April, WHO held a global, online consultation on managing the COVID-19 infodemic (An infodemic is an over-abundance of information, some accurate and some not that makes it hard for people to find trustworthy sources and reliable guidance). For conference material see link below.




