## Situation Report No. 32 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 16 April 2020

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Total 1,524 confirmed cases, 119 new cases.
- No new mortalities recorded.
- 1,296 cases remain under treatment, 32 of them are in critical condition.
- Recovery of 19 coronavirus cases bringing total to 225.
- 1,367 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Out of the 119 new cases, 9 are Kuwaiti citizens and 110 are expatriates.
- UN: Kuwait sought no help to repatriate illegal residents.
- Kuwait receives second shipment of medical facemask producing machines.
- 75 flights will start repatriating Kuwaiti citizens from 16 countries starting next Sunday.
- 600 doctors trained on taking nasal samples in anticipation of returning citizens.
- WHO releases new guidance on safe Ramadan practices in context of COVID-19 (see link below).




