HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 1,751 confirmed cases, 93 new cases.
- 1 new mortality recorded, a 68 years old Bangladeshi resident.
- 1,465 cases remain under treatment, 34 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 18 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 22 cases bringing total to 280.
- 1,367 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Out of the 93 new cases, 3 are Kuwaiti citizens and 90 are expatriates.
- Minister of Social Affairs: Companies violating workers' residencies pay for sheltering, deportation.
- WHO releases new guidance on safe Ramadan practices in context of COVID-19 (see link below).




