Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 19 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 1,915 confirmed cases, 164 new cases.
- 1 new mortality recorded, a 60 years old Indian resident.
- 1,603 cases remain under treatment, 38 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 20 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 25 coronavirus cases bringing total to 305.
- 1,367 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Out of the 164 new cases, 8 are Kuwaiti citizens and 156 are expatriates.
- "Home quarantine procedures" approved by Health Minister.
- MoH uses a new app to monitor home-quarantined returnees. The mandatory application "Shlonik" helps monitor abiding by the quarantine. An electronic bracelet will be provided to aid enforcement of home quarantine.
- Kuwait's Emir urges the public to adhere to the preventative measures issued by the MoH to curb the coronavirus outbreak in a televised speech.
- WHO releases new guidance on safe Ramadan practices in context of COVID-19 (see link below).




