# Situation Report No. 37- Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 21 April 2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Total 2,080 confirmed cases, 85 new cases.
- 2 new mortalities recorded, a 63 years old Somali resident and a 59 years old Bangladeshi resident.
- 1,657 cases remain under treatment, 46 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 20 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 45 coronavirus cases bringing total to 412.
- 1,367 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Out of the 85 new cases, 17 are Kuwaiti citizens and 68 are expatriates.
- Health Minister condemns assault on medical cadres.
- MoH to allow private health sector to resume some of its activities with some precautionary measures, and encourages online consultations (for details see link below).




