Situation Report No. 41 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 25 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 2,892 confirmed cases, 278 new cases. 36 of the new cases are nationals, and the remaining 242 are expatriates.
- 4 new mortalities: a 74 years Kuwaiti national, and 3 expatriates 45 64 years of age.
- 2,217 cases remain under treatment, 58 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 25 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 43 cases bringing total recovered to 656.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Repatriation of Kuwaiti citizens continues.
- Kuwait Ministry of Public Works builds a new 5,000-bed quarantine facility, hands over 1,250 beds to the MoH, and the remaining beds will be completed later.
- WHO launches an online course on managing COVID-19 cases and outbreaks in aviation (see link below).




