## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Total 3,288 confirmed cases, 213 new cases. 74 of the new cases are nationals, and the remaining 139 are expatriates.
- 31 of the new cases are travel related, 177 are contacts of cases and 5 are other cases.
- 2 new mortalities recorded, a 53 years Kuwaiti national and a 54 years resident.
- 2,254 cases remain under treatment, 64 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 30 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 206 coronavirus cases bringing total to 1,012.
- 2,095 individuals are quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Kuwait Cabinet decides to reopen auto repair shops and car spare parts shops.
- Three stores sealed for violating health precautions.
- Kuwait's MoH refers home quarantine violators to Ministry of Interior for questioning and could face charges.
- WHO scientific brief discusses the role of measuring COVID-19 antibodies in understanding infection status/history, showing that there is no evidence that they protect from reinfection (see link below).




