Situation Report No. 44 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 28 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Total 3,440 confirmed cases, 152 new cases. 40 of the new cases are nationals, and the remaining 112 are expatriates.

• 15 of the new cases are travel related, 128 are contacts of cases and 9 are under investigation.

• 1 new mortality recorded, a 61 years old resident.

• 2,241 cases remain under treatment, 67 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 30 are in a critical condition.

- Recovery of 164 cases bringing total to 1,176.
- 2,095 individuals are guarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Kuwaiti Health Minister receives Chinese medical team.
- Due to the limited quantities available in the local market, Ministry of Trade:
- Adding medical masks to the ration card starting in May 2020.
- Law enforcers interrogate girl over violation of curfew.
- WHO document provides guidance regarding the operation of immunization programs in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic (see link below).




