HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,065 new cases, bringing total to 8,688. Of the new cases 192 are nationals.
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 9 new mortalities, bringing total to 58.
- 5,901 cases remain under treatment, 114 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 45 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 107 cases bringing total to 2,729.
- 2,619 individuals are guarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- MOI: Kuwaiti female police officer contracts coronavirus. Other reports of COVID-19 cases in men's prison and two deaths are "incorrect".
- Kuwait's Public Authority for Civil Information issues hyperlink for medical permits during lockdown.
- MOH to accelerate the mechanism of drug registration and license 11 local factories for medical disinfectants.




