HIGHLIGHTS

- 991 new cases, bringing total to 10,277. Of the new cases 138 are nationals.
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 10 new mortalities, bringing total to 75.
- 7,101 cases remain under treatment, 158 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 74 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 194 coronavirus cases bringing total to 3,101.
- MoH: 128 residential buildings quarantined due to spread of COVID-19, 15 Co-Ops inspected.
- 366 Kuwaiti citizens cross Nuwaiseeb border crossing, returning from Saudi Arabia.
- Foreign Minister: There are 19 people who have been receiving treatment for the Coronavirus abroad since January, 7 of them have died.
- Kuwaiti Minister of Health: citizens and residents have to wear a protective mask or covering the nose by any means in all public places, throughout the period of their presence in those places with a commitment to social distance between each person and another.
- Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers. (see link below).


