## Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

### Situation Report No. 57 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 17 May 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,048 new cases, bringing total to 14,850. Of the new cases 242 are nationals.
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 5 new mortalities, bringing total to 112.
- 10,645 cases remain under treatment, 168 of them are in ICU.
- Recovery of 250 coronavirus cases bringing total to 4,093.
- Mol apprehends an Arab expat who violated curfew rules and quarrelled with army personnel.
- MoH launches drive-thru coronavirus testing site.
- WHO: Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers; WHO has published new guidance on "Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces in the context of COVID-19"; WHO provided guidance on school related public health measures (see links below).




