## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 841 new cases, bringing total to 15,691. Of the new cases 162 are nationals.
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 6 new mortalities, bringing total to 118.
- 11,234 cases remain under treatment, 161 of them are in ICU.
- Recovery of 246 coronavirus cases bringing total to 4,339.
- Kuwait participates in the meetings of the 73rd session of the World Health Assembly with a delegation headed by the Minister of Health.
- Municipality closes 175 shops for violation of mitigation measures.
- Violation of the compulsory use of a protective face mask or any suitable alternative is punishable by jail for a maximum period of 3 months and/or a maximum fine of 5000 Kuwaiti Dinar.
- MoH announces a the mechanism for ending the home quarantine and handing the bracelet to the Ministry of Health.
- WHO: Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers; WHO has published new guidance on "Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces in the context of COVID-19"; WHO provided guidance on school related public health measures (see links below).
