### Situation Report No. 60 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 20 May 2020

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 804 new cases, bringing total to 17,568. Of the new cases 170 are nationals.
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 3 new mortalities, bringing total to 124.
- 12,559 cases remain under treatment, 167 of them are in ICU.
- Recovery of 204 coronavirus cases bringing total to 4,885.
- MoH: Gates and sterilization rooms in public places are ineffective against Coronavirus.
- Kuwaiti Fire Service Directorate: Opening of quarantine for firefighters.
- Citizens returns to Kuwait from Mexico on special flights.
- WHO: Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers; WHO has published new guidance on "Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces in the context of COVID-19"; WHO provided guidance on school related public health measures (see links below).
