HIGHLIGHTS

- 5,699 new cases in 7 days, bringing total to 23,267. New cases follow a downward trend.
- Of the new cases 1,120 are nationals.
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 51 new mortalities, bringing total to 175.
- 15,146 cases remain under treatment, 193 of them are in ICU.
- Recovery of 3,061 cases bringing total to 7,946.
- Civil Service Commission sets rules for gradual work resumption.
- Kuwait government to turn to partial curfew on the 30th of May, details to be announced on the 29th of May.
- MoH sets out treatment mechanism for infected medics.
- WHO: Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers; WHO has published new guidance on "Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces in the context of COVID-19".




