# Situation Report No. 64 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 1 June 2020

## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 719 new cases bringing total to 27,762; of the new cases 265 (36.9%) are nationals.
- Infected cases by health area: Al Farwaniyah (209), Al Ahmadi (184), Al Jahra (170), Hawally (101) and Capital Area (55).
- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 8 new mortalities, bringing total to 220.
- 14,643 cases remain under treatment, 204 of them are in ICU.
- Recovery of 1,513 cases bringing total recovered to 12,899.
- 3,664 new PCR tests conducted bringing total to 297,026.
- Ministry of Interior to extend, up to three months, residency permits and visas of all expatriates, which were due to expire in June.
- US ambassador to Kuwait announces that issuing visas to the USA will resume on the 22nd of June with priority given to student visas.
- Qatar Airlines announces opening reservations for departures from Kuwait.
- WHO released two new documents: key planning recommendations for mass gatherings in the context of COVID-19; and, technical guidance for the prevention and control of COVID-19 across long-term care services (see links below).
- WHO lists all candidate COVID-19 vaccines in various stages of development without endorsing any of them (see link below).
