## Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

### Situation Report No. 67 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 06 June 2020

#### HIGHLIGHTS

• 1,772 new cases in 3 days, bringing total to 31,131; of the new cases 634 (35.8%) are nationals.

- All new cases are contacts of cases or are under investigation.
- 24 new mortalities in 3 days, bringing total to 254.
- 11,595 cases remain under treatment, 180 of them are in ICU.
- Recovery of 3,532 cases bringing total to 19,282.
- 8,339 new PCR tests conducted bringing total to 311,624.
- Kuwait to receive the COVID-19 medication "Avigan" from Japan at no cost; Kuwait will also receive "Remdesivir" this month to be evaluated by the solidarity trial.
- 300 doctors and nurses specialized to handle coronavirus patients arrive from Cuba.
- Secretary General Guterres expresses gratitude to Kuwait for their COVID-19 support.
- Kuwait Red Crescent continues to distribute food baskets in Jeleeb Al-Shuyoukh which is currently under lock down.
- Media not permitted entry into lockdown areas.
- MoH affirms coronavirus PCR tests are being conducted as usual.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below)




