# Situation Report No. 68 - Kuwait

#### Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 07 June 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

• 717 new cases bringing total to 31,848 ; of the new cases 331 (46.2%) are nationals.

• Infected cases by health area: Al Farwaniyah (241), Al Ahmadi (204), Al Jahra (139), Hawally (74) and Capital Area (59).

- 10 new mortalities, bringing total to 264.
- Recovery of 923 cases bringing total recovered to 20,205.
- 11,379 cases remain under treatment, 196 of them are in ICU.
- 3,661 new PCR tests conducted bringing total to 315,285.
- Kuwait to reopen mosques in some areas as of Wednesday.

• Kuwait University launches an electronic application to receive and arbitrate master's and doctorate degrees.

• Pilot start-up of the Rapid Detection Centre for the detection of Covid-19 via intravehicle inspection at Jaber Stadium

• Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) prepared three-phase plan to resume commercial flights.

- Lockdown areas under assessment for easing measures.
- Ministry of Education needs 450 nurses by August in schools.

• WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.




