HIGHLIGHTS

- 662 new cases bringing total to 32,510; of the new cases 340 (51.4%) are nationals.
- Infected cases by health area: Al Farwaniyah (201), Al Ahmadi (188), Al Jahra (123), Hawally (98) and Capital Area (52).
- 5 new mortalities, bringing total to 269.
- Recovery of 1,037 cases bringing total recovered to 21,242.
- 10,999 cases remain under treatment, 166 of them are in ICU.
- 2,999 new PCR tests conducted bringing total to 318,284.
- The Kuwaiti Red Crescent distributes 150 food parcels to needy families.
- The lockdown of the Hawally area will continue until further notice.
- Kuwait International Airport will witness the departure of 4,475 passengers on Monday, the majority of whom are Egyptians, on board 22 flights.
- WHO updates guidance on the use of face masks in context of COVID-19 (see link below), and stresses that mask use is only one component of a comprehensive approach to prevent and control COVID-19 and should be adopted with hand hygiene, physical distancing and other measures.




